

# TURKEY FEEDING GUIDE

Average Pounds of Feed Per Bird Consumed During Each Two Week Period

## STARTER FEED

1-2 WEEKS	0.60 <i>lbs</i>
3-4 WEEKS	1.75 <i>lbs</i>
5-6 WEEKS	1.90 <i>lbs</i>
<b>STARTER TOTAL</b>	<b>4.25 <i>lbs per bird</i></b>

## GROWER FEED

7-8 WEEKS	2.75 <i>lbs</i>
9-10 WEEKS	3.50 <i>lbs</i>
11-12 WEEKS	4.30 <i>lbs</i>
13-14 WEEKS	5.50 <i>lbs</i>
<b>GROWER TOTAL</b>	<b>16.05 <i>lbs per bird</i></b>

## FINISHER FEED

15-16 WEEKS	5.75 <i>lbs</i>
17-18 WEEKS	6.65 <i>lbs</i>
19-20 WEEKS	7.00 <i>lbs</i>
21-22 WEEKS <i>[optional]</i>	8.00 <i>lbs</i>
23-24 WEEKS <i>[optional]</i>	8.25 <i>lbs</i>
25-26 WEEKS <i>[optional]</i>	8.25 <i>lbs</i>
27-28 WEEKS <i>[optional]</i>	8.50 <i>lbs</i>
<b>EST. TOTAL</b>	<b>19.4 <i>lbs per bird</i></b>

**EST. FINISH WEIGHT** ... *Approx. 24 lbs*

**DRESS WEIGHT** ... *Approx. 80%*  
*[of Est. Finish Weight]*



Estimates are based on test flocks raised for a full 28 weeks under normal conditions, although average turkey finish dates occur during the 20th week. Results vary, impacted by the quality of living conditions, weather, stress, and management style. Provide access to feed and clean water at all times. A day without feed will result in weight loss and inhibited growth. Finisher feed quantities depend on desired dress weights.
